



Featured Artist

Thank you for your interest in the Farragut Arts Council Featured Artist Program.

Purpose: The Farragut Arts Council is one of ten standing committees that serve the Town of Farragut. The Council is comprised of volunteers whose mission is to advise and assist the Town of Farragut, its citizens and its staff in artistic and cultural activities. The Council serves as an advocate for artistic and cultural issues in the Town's decision-making process and provides guidance and support in implementing actions that promote art and culture for citizens of the Farragut community.

One of the goals of the Council is "to increase the access to and the availability of the arts." The Featured Artist program is an opportunity to feature the work of established and emerging artists and craftsman in the Farragut community.

Eligibility: The exhibit is open to all artists working in all media. Work must be sized to fit into the display cases (see attached guidelines for specifications.) **Due to the limitations of the display cases, you are encouraged to view the display area prior to application.** All work must be original. Exhibit will continue for approximately 1 calendar month.

Fee: There is no fee associated with the program. Artist must provide all display materials.

Submission: Please mail the attached application to: Featured Artist, Town of Farragut, ATTN: Anne LaGrow, 11408 Municipal Center Drive, Farragut, TN 37934. Attach at least 3 photographs of your work (non-returnable.) Additional information about the exhibit or artist may be attached and may be used in press releases.

Notification of Acceptance: The chairman of the Featured Artist subcommittee will present recommendations to the Arts Council on a quarterly basis: February, April, August and November. Artists will be notified by mail about the status of their application.
