Call to Order

Approval of Minutes

School Updates

Farragut Primary School

Michell Morrow provided the following updates:

- Online basket auction will be April 8 – 13, 2021
- Teacher Appreciation Week will be May 3 – 7, 2021
- Working on a “Photos with Finley” day

Farragut Intermediate School

Elizabeth Munk provided the following updates:

- Had a one-hour long dance-a-thon fundraiser called Farragut Footloose. The goal was to raise \$10,000; raised \$29,500.
- Teacher Appreciation Week will be May 17 – 21, 2021

Farragut Middle School

Beth Duncan provided the following updates:

- Farragut Middle School PTO raised \$8,000 so far for the Admiral Out Campaign
- Working on something for 8th graders since the school cannot have the 8th Grade Dance
- The middle school will have field day

Farragut High School

Mary Nussbaum provided the following updates:

- Baccalaureate will be on May 9, 2021 at First Baptist Concord
- Will have prom on May 1, 2021 at the Venue at Lenoir City
- Graduation has been moved to June 6, 2021

Mary Cook provided an overview of the Farragut High School Foundation's role.

Hannah Brennan provided the following updates:

- Currently running for Student Government Association Vice President and was elected the Service Coordinator for National Honor Society.
- The Love Kitchen Can Food Drive was held on March 1, 2021 and incorporated all the public schools in Farragut which collected a total of 37,000 cans; this total is the total number of cans collected and the total dollars collected converted to can numbers. Approximately \$6,000 was donated to the can food drive through the Give Butter account.
- The SGA intends to move the Can Food Drive back to the Fall in 2022.
