



Committee Descriptions and Meeting Information

ARTS COUNCIL: Mission is to further the arts through programs and events. Meetings are held on the **first Tuesday of each month at 4 p.m.** and members are expected to be “hands-on” participants in council sponsored events. Appointments are for two years.

BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE: Mission is to coordinate holiday decorations for Farragut and to judge yearly Beautification Awards. This committee is a working committee in that members are required to work at special events. Meetings are at **1:30 p.m. on the second Tuesday of March, August, October and November.** Appointments are for two years – 11 members.

BOARD OF PLUMBING AND GAS/MECHANICAL EXAMINERS: Purpose is to advise the Board of Mayor and Aldermen regarding the standards and procedures for the qualifications of applicants desiring a license as required by the Town’s ordinance and approves applications of those requesting licensing. This Board also serves as the appeals body for property maintenance issues as needed. **Meetings are scheduled as needed.** Appointments are for three years – 7 members.

BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS (BZA): Hears citizen appeals and requests for special exceptions to the zoning and sign ordinances. Meetings are at **7 p.m. on the fourth Wednesday** of each month. Appointments are for the five years – 5 members.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE: Purpose is to provide the Town Staff and Board of Mayor and Aldermen with recommendations related to economic development activities, policies, and procedures impacting the Town of Farragut. Meetings are at **8 a.m. on the first Wednesday** of each month. Appointments are for four years – 8 members.

MUSEUM COMMITTEE: Purpose is responsible for the promotion of special events and exhibits, membership, and recruiting and training volunteers to preserve the heritage of our East Tennessee community. This committee is a working committee in that members are required to work at special events and serve as docents. Meetings are at **1:30 p.m. on the fourth Tuesday** of each month. Appointments are for two years – 15 members.

KNOX COUNTY SCHOOLS EDUCATION RELATIONS COMMITTEE: Purpose is to provide a forum for joint discussion and collaboration on issues involving the Town and Knox County Schools. Meetings are at **4 p.m. on the first Tuesday** of February, April, June, August, October, December, and as needed. Appointments are for two years – 5 members.

PARKS & ATHLETICS COUNCIL: This council makes recommendations about the development of recreational facilities, policies and athletic field allocations. Meetings are on a **Tuesday evening during the months of January, June, August and November** and members are expected to be “hands-on” participants in council sponsored events. Appointments are for two years – 9 members.

PERSONNEL COMMITTEE: Purpose is to provide recommendations to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on personnel policies, salary surveys, job descriptions and other related matters. Meetings are scheduled as needed at **6 p.m. on the third Tuesday** of the month as needed. Appointments are for two years – 7 members.

STORMWATER ADVISORY COMMITTEE: Purpose is to provide advice and assistance to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen, the Municipal Planning Commission and Town staff on the stormwater management program. Meetings are at **3:30 p.m. on the second Thursday** of each month. Appointments are for two years – 7 members.

VISUAL RESOURCES REVIEW BOARD (VRRB): Purpose is to review proposed Town sign permits and landscaping plans and present recommendations to the Town staff. Meetings are **7 p.m. on the fourth Tuesday** of each month. Appointments are for two years – 7 members.
