

## McFee Park Phase 3 – Questions & Answers

- What are the hours of the park?  
Dawn to 10 p.m.
- What hours are the restrooms open?  
8 a.m. to 9 p.m. 7 days a week.
- How many tennis/pickleball courts?  
There are 4 tennis courts that can be converted into 8 pickleball courts.
- What does it cost to play tennis/pickleball?  
Cost for a reservation is \$5 per hour session for pickleball. You must reserve two pickleball courts for a tennis reservation.  
Reservations may be made by calling 218-3376 Monday through Thursday from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m.; Fridays 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturdays 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Reservations are set for 1-hour blocks starting at 8:30 a.m. and ending at 9:30 p.m.  
Reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance. Reservations are for a specific court – a map of the courts is located on the kiosk at the courts.  
If there are no reservations, courts may be used for free on a first come first serve basis. However, anyone dropping in will need to vacate the court at the start time of a reservation. To check to see if a court has a reservation, please scan the QR codes located at the court kiosk to see if a court is open or go online at [farragutparksandrec.org/register](http://farragutparksandrec.org/register).
- Do I need to bring my own tennis/pickleball equipment?  
Tennis nets are permanently installed on the courts, temporary pickleball nets will be provided by and set up every day by Parks & Recreation staff.  
Paddles, racquets and balls will not be provided.
- How many of the courts will be for tennis and how many for pickleball?  
All courts are set up for pickleball and tennis. For tennis use, you must reserve two pickleball courts.
- Are the courts lighted?  
Yes, but only for those with reservations. Lights will not be available for drop-in use. Lights are computerized and will turn on before dusk and off at 9:45 p.m. for those nights with reservations.
- What type of maintenance will be done to prepare courts?  
Parks and recreation and public works staff will clear the courts of debris after severe storms (as staffing allows) and on an occasional basis otherwise. A broom and squeegee will be provided at the courts for users to clear courts themselves as desired.

- **What about the basketball court – what are those rules and fees?**

The basketball court will be open each day at 8 a.m. and close at 9:45 p.m. The court can be reserved 8:30am - 9:30pm. Reservations may be made by calling 218-3376 Monday through Thursday from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m.; Fridays 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturdays 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Reservations are set for 1-hour blocks starting at 8:30 a.m. and ending at 9:30 p.m.

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Drop-in use is welcome if the court has not been reserved. Challenge court rules apply if there are others waiting to play and the court has not been reserved.

- **How can I rent the Grand Special Event Pavilion?**

- **What is the distance of the walk trail?**

Walk trail around the great lawn is .75 miles and is ADA accessible.
